Regular Meeting

August 12, 2019

Mayor Pro Tem Frank Carden opened the meeting at 7:03. In attendance was the aforementioned Mayor Pro Tem Frank Carden as well as Councilman Kenny Wright and Councilman Jack Gilson. Mayor Gary Laggis was absent. The minutes of the July meeting were approved, with Councilman Gilson making the motion to approve them and he was seconded by Councilman Wright. Motion passed.

The Financial Report (see attached) was approved, with Councilman Wright making the motion to approve and he was seconded by Councilman Gilson. Motion passed.

Old Business

1. Intersection Update – Mayor Laggis and Councilman Carden met with Mike Gumbinger, Phil Mallon and Joe Robertson again to discuss the alternatives for the Hwy 92/Hampton Rd intersections. The Consultants have determined that the most feasible alternatives would be #3 (turn lanes and southbound light) or #4 (roundabout). Mayor Laggis and Councilman Carden were asked if there were any that they would not support, and even though, as citizens of Woolsey, they would prefer the realignment of the two Hampton Rds, they know that it would be very costly and take years to complete, if it could happen at all. Any fix is still 2-3 years out. Once the decision is made, there will be an informational meeting for the residents of Woolsey.

2. Other – Councilman Wright showed the council his idea for the “community bulletin board”, but idea was tabled until the September meeting.
