

# TOWN of WOOLSEY

## Regular Meeting

July 8, 2019

Mayor Laggis opened the meeting at 7:04pm. In attendance were Mayor Laggis as well as Councilman Carden, Councilman Wright and Councilman Gilson. Daryl Hicks, the Chairman of the Board of the Fayette County Development Authority gave a presentation to the Town Council explaining what the FCDA does and how it impacts Woolsey. Their job is to recruit businesses to the county, which would bring jobs and tax dollars to Fayette County, which in turn helps the Town of Woolsey and its citizens.

The minutes of the June meeting were approved, with Councilman Carden making the motion to approve them and he was seconded by Councilman Gilson. Motion passed.

The Financial Report (see attached) was approved, with Councilman Wright making the motion to approve and he was seconded by Councilman Carden. Motion passed. Discussion was had about obtaining a debit card for purchases that have to be made, instead of having to reimburse the purchaser. Clerk will look into feasibility.

### Old Business

1. Transportation/Intersection Update – still no decision made, but the dual timed signals were ruled out as not passing the level of service to make it possible. Another option was also discussed, which is a roundabout by the Chevron and a light with turn lane by the WCC. Concern that the turn lane could back up the roundabout. Transportation committee meeting will be held on 7/9/19.

### New Business

1. Rain Gutter for Town Hall – Rain washing away the mulch on the side of building. Councilman Gilson made a motion to spend up to \$800 for a gutter to be installed and he was seconded by Councilman Wright. Motion passed.

2. Zoning Administrator/Enforcement – it was decided to look into hiring or contracting a zoning administrator to take it off of the Council. Will also look to possibly do the permitting instead of Woolsey citizens having to obtain a letter from the Town and then deal with Fayette County.

3. 6 Month Revenue and Expense Comparison – everything appears to be on target.

4. Other – Councilman Wright is looking into building something for public notices.

With no more business to come before the Council, the meeting was adjourned at 7:50pm.
