Regular Meeting

October 14, 2024

Mayor Laggis opened the meeting at 7:00 pm. Councilman Wright was absent.

Minutes of Prior Meeting

Councilman Carden made a motion to accept the August minutes as presented. He was seconded by Councilman Smith. Motion passed unanimously.

Financial Report

Councilman Smith made the motion to approve the September and October Financial Reports. Councilman Carden seconded him. Motion passed unanimously.

Old Business

1. Transportation Committee Update – Mayor Laggis introduced Karen Graiser as our new representative on the Transportation Committee. She reported that the roundabout will have a solid curb for the pass-through lane going south. Mayor Laggis said that the light poles will be “period type”, which was part of the original plans. He also said that the County has the contacts for the right-of-way acquisitions, but has not started that process. Finally, he told the Council that Brian Keller is awaiting the approval from the Sheriff before they install the No Parking Except on Shoulder signs near the antique store.

2. Program of Work Updates – There has been no word from David Ballard in regards to the annexation. Mayor Laggis has spoken with his neighbor, who is going to think about potentially requesting to be annexed in to the Town. In regards to the lot, Councilman Smith said that the size was 50’x100’, could add space for parking for 7-9 more cars. Councilman Carden still needs to speak with Maurice Ungaro about the Tree Ordinance.

New Business

1. Public Safety Breakfast – Mayor Laggis and possibly Councilman Smith cannot be in attendance on December 7th. Discussed moving it to December 14th. Tabled until the November meeting.
